### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Owner and the Hirer for the hiring of the Goods and no other terms, whether made orally or in writing, will apply to this Agreement unless the Owner has agreed in writing to them.

#### **1 Agreement and Hire Period**

- 1.1** The Owner agrees to hire and the Hirer agrees to take on hire the Goods, with an option to purchase the same, on the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- 1.2** The hiring of the Goods shall commence on the Date of this Agreement and shall continue thereafter for the Hire Period unless terminated earlier in accordance with this Agreement.

#### **2 Payments**

- 2.1** The Hirer shall pay to the Owner the Payments at the rate and at the intervals determined overleaf and/or in any Payments Schedule entered into by the Hirer and the Owner.
- 2.2** The Hirer shall pay to the Owner the Documentation Fee (plus VAT) together with the first Payment.
- 2.3** The Hirer agrees that all payments under this Agreement shall be made to the Owner's bank account as specified by the Owner by Direct Debit, or to such other account, also by Direct Debit, as may be advised by the Owner to the Hirer from time to time.
- 2.4** The Hirer agrees to pay interest if it fails to pay any amount payable by it under this Agreement on its due date. Interest shall accrue on the amount payable but unpaid from the due date up to the date of actual payment, both before and after judgment or decree, at the rate of 5% per annum above the base rate of the Bank of England from time to time. In addition, a charge will be levied for each notice sent by the Owner to the Hirer in respect of a default under this Agreement. A copy of the Owner's tariff of charges is available to the Hirer on request.
- 2.5** The Hirer shall make all Payments and other sums due under this Agreement without demand free and clear of any taxes, deductions or withholdings of any nature whatsoever and without limitation to the foregoing, the Hirer shall not be entitled to assert any right or defence, set-off, deferment or counterclaim against the Owner in order to justify withholding payment of any Payment whether in whole or in part, or any other sum that may be due to the Owner.
- 2.6** The Hirer agrees that there shall not be any rebate or deferral of any Payment during any period in which the Goods are not working, are not in the Hirer's possession, are unserviceable or are unavailable for use for any reason. The payment of any sums payable by the Hirer under this Agreement shall not be affected in any way by the loss, damage, theft, Total Loss (as defined in clause 8.1 below) of or any defect in the Goods.
- 2.7** If the Hirer is required by law to make any payment due under this Agreement subject to deductions or withholdings for any reason whatsoever, the Hirer shall pay to the Owner such additional sums as are necessary to ensure that the Owner receives and retains a net sum equal to the sum that the Owner should have received and retained had no such deduction or withholding been made or required to have been made.
- 2.8** All sums due to the Owner under this Agreement are (unless otherwise stated) exclusive of VAT, which shall be charged in accordance with the relevant regulations in force at the time of making the relevant taxable supply and shall be paid by the Hirer.
- 2.9** The Hirer agrees to pay the Owner's costs and expenses (including legal costs on a full indemnity basis) and those of the Owner's agent for taking steps to recover any payment due or otherwise to enforce the Owner's rights under this Agreement.
- 2.10** The Hirer agrees that if it or its auditors or any person on its behalf requests the Owner at any time to provide information or details regarding this Agreement or any payment due under it or any auditor's certificate or other document then the Owner shall, if it accedes to such request, make such charge therefor in accordance with the Owner's tariff of charges (available to the Hirer on request), which will be payable by the Hirer on demand.
- 2.11** The Hirer agrees that if it would otherwise be required to make any payment under this Agreement on a day which is not a Business Day, it shall do so instead on the next Business Day, if that is within the same calendar month, or, otherwise, on the preceding Business Day.

#### **3 Option to Purchase**

- 3.1** Upon expiry of the Hire Period by passage of time, if the Hirer has paid all the Payments and other sums due and payable under this Agreement, and provided that none of the events specified in clause 10 has occurred, then the Hirer will have the option to purchase the Goods by paying the Option to Purchase Fee to the Owner.
- 3.2** If Hirer does not pay the Option to Purchase Fee to the Owner within 7 days from the expiry of the Hire Period then the option to purchase the Goods will expire and the Hirer shall return the Goods to the Owner in accordance with clause 12 below.
- 3.3** Upon the Hirer exercising its option to purchase the Goods in accordance with clause 3.1 above and the Owner having received the Option to Purchase Fee in cleared funds, title to the Goods shall pass to the Hirer on an "as is where is" basis and all guarantees, warranties, terms, conditions and representations (express or implied) relating to such Goods shall be excluded by the Owner to the maximum extent permitted by law (save that the Owner will pass good title to the Goods to the Hirer and that the Owner has not encumbered such title). Until such time that title passes to the Hirer pursuant to this clause 3, title to the Goods shall not vest in the Hirer and the Hirer shall be a mere bailee, or, in Scotland, hirer, of the Goods.

#### **4 Acceptance and Delivery of the Goods**

- 4.1** The Hirer is responsible for collecting and taking delivery of the Goods. The Owner shall not be liable to the Hirer for any delay in the delivery of the Goods.
- 4.2** The Hirer shall notify the Owner in writing of any defect in the Goods on delivery. If no such notification is received from the Hirer within 5 days of delivery of the Goods then the Owner shall conclusively presume that the Goods are complete and in good order and condition and of satisfactory quality and in every way satisfactory and acceptable to the Hirer. Without prejudice to the above, the Hirer shall sign a certificate of acceptance in respect of the Goods if required by the Owner, in a form acceptable to the Owner, and such certificate shall be conclusive and binding on the Hirer in confirming that the Goods are satisfactory and accepted by them.

#### **5 Use and care of the Goods**

- 5.1** The Hirer shall be responsible for any loss, theft, destruction of or damage to the Goods from the date of delivery of the Goods to the Hirer until they are sold, recovered by the Owner or otherwise disposed of.
- 5.2** The Hirer shall, at its own cost, keep the Goods properly serviced, maintained and in working order, good repair and condition. All servicing and maintenance must be carried out by properly trained and qualified personnel, strictly in accordance with the recommendations of the manufacturer and/or supplier of the Goods. Any replacement parts and lubricants used must be manufactured to the standard and specification recommended by the manufacturer of the Goods and the Hirer shall maintain complete records in writing of all service, maintenance and repair to the Goods. All replacement parts fixed to the Goods will belong to the Owner and will be subject to the terms of this Agreement.
- 5.3** The Goods will remain personal and moveable property even if temporarily fixed to land or buildings and if the Goods become fixed to land or buildings the Hirer will make sure that any person who has an interest in the land (including, without limitation, in Scotland, a standard security holder) from time to time gives the Owner, in writing, a waiver of any right to the Goods and a right to enter land and remove the Goods. If requested by the Owner the Hirer will attach the Owner's name plate to the Goods.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS (*continued*)

- 5.4** The Hirer shall inform the Owner immediately if the Hirer changes its address. The Hirer will not change the location of the Goods from the Goods Location specified overleaf and/or in any separate Goods Schedule (entered into between the Hirer and the Owner) without the Owner's prior written consent. Where the Goods are vehicles, the Hirer may use the Goods in the European Union (Permitted Area) for 21 consecutive days at a time. The Hirer will obtain and maintain in force at all relevant times all licences and permissions required to operate the vehicles lawfully in the Permitted Area. The Hirer will ensure that the insurances maintained by it covers the use of the vehicles in the Permitted Area and the cost of any repatriation expenses incurred in connection with the vehicles.
- 5.5** The Hirer will allow the Owner or its duly authorised agent(s) or representative's access upon reasonable notice at any time to any land or premises where the Goods are situated, to inspect and test the Goods and inspect any records, log book, manual or hand book forming part of the Goods.
- 5.6** The Hirer shall not make any alterations, enhancements, modifications or additions to the Goods (except where required by law) without the Owner's prior written consent. Title to any replacements of and accessories and additions made to the Goods shall immediately vest in the Owner.
- 5.7** The Hirer will ensure that the Goods are always used legally (which, for the avoidance of doubt, means in accordance with any statute or other rule, regulation or order) and in a careful and proper manner by properly trained and skilled personnel in strict accordance with the operating instructions issued by the manufacturer and/or supplier of the Goods and the government, agency or any statutory authority.
- 5.8** The Hirer shall keep the Goods in its possession and under its control and shall keep the Goods free from any lien, pledge, charge, hypothec or other encumbrance or security interest. The Hirer shall not sell (or attempt to sell), assign, transfer, mortgage, lend, let, sublet, license or give the Goods to anyone or otherwise part with possession of the Goods without the Owner's prior written consent.
- 5.9** The Hirer will not permit the Goods to be used in contravention of any patents or other intellectual property rights of third parties.
- 5.10** The Hirer will at all times, at its cost, maintain in full force and effect, all permissions, certificates, licences, registration, permits and authorisations required by any governmental or statutory authority in connection with the Goods and/or the premises in which the Goods are kept and if the Goods comprises of vehicles the Hirer will at all times ensure that each vehicle is validly licensed, has a current Department of Transport Test Certificate (or any equivalent certificate) and complies with all other requirements as to inspection, testing, plating, insurance and otherwise as for the time being required by law.
- 5.11** If the Goods are a vehicle to which the Goods Vehicles (Licensing of Operators) Act 1995 applies, then the Hirer must ensure that any operator of the vehicle, including any person to whom the Hirer may, with the permission of the Owner, sublet the vehicle, possesses a valid operator's licence for the vehicle. The Owner may request to see evidence of this licence at any time during the term of this Agreement.
- 5.12** If the Goods are a vehicle or comprised of vehicles, the Hirer will pay any charges, fines or other fixed penalties relating to the vehicle immediately. If the Hirer fails to do so the Owner may pay the amount of the charge, fine or penalty on behalf of the Hirer. The Hirer shall repay that amount to the Owner on demand together with such sum as the Owner considers reasonable to cover its administration costs connected with the charge, fine or fixed penalty. Details of the Owner's charges are available on request and will be notified to the Hirer in any event before the Hirer incurs such charge.
- 5.13** Where the Goods includes software, the Hirer shall obtain all software licences necessary for the use and operation of the Goods, the Hirer shall comply with the terms of such software licences and indemnify the Owner against any claim made against the Owner for breach of such software licences. The Owner does not license any software and is not liable for any failure of any software.
- 6 Disclaimers and Exclusions**
- 6.1** The Hirer represents and warrants that it has taken and is relying on its own independent tax and accounting advice in respect of the transaction the subject of this Agreement and has not relied on any advice or statement made by the Owner (or any of its agents) in entering into the Agreement.
- 6.2** Nothing in this Agreement shall exclude or limit the Owner's liability in relation to:
- 6.2.1** any death or personal injury arising from the Owner's negligence or that of the Owner's employees;
- 6.2.2** any act of fraud committed by the Owner or any fraudulent misrepresentation made by the Owner; or
- 6.2.3** any other liability which cannot be excluded by law.
- 6.3** In no event will the Owner be liable to the Hirer in contract, tort, delict or any other area of law including any liability for negligence:
- 6.3.1** for any loss of revenue, business, anticipated savings or profits or any loss of use or value; or
- 6.3.2** for any indirect or consequential loss or damage,
- in each case, however caused or arising, even if foreseeable.
- 6.4** The Hirer is responsible for selecting the Goods and making sure that they are fit and suitable for the Hirer's purpose. The Owner is not a dealer or expert in the Goods and has given no advice or assurances about the Goods or their quality or suitability. The Hirer acknowledges that the Owner only finances the Goods and that the Goods are acquired by the Owner at the Hirer's request solely for the purpose of hiring the Goods to the Hirer.
- 6.5** The Hirer and the Owner recognise that there is a risk that the Goods may not perform as expected and may not be satisfactory to the Hirer and appreciate that the allocation of risk is a matter of agreement between the Parties. The Hirer and the Owner have agreed that the Hirer shall bear this risk on the terms set out in this clause 6.
- 6.6** The Owner does not hire or supply the Goods to the Hirer with any guarantee, warranty, term, condition or representation (express or implied) concerning the condition, description, suitability, quality, fitness for purpose, performance or age of the Goods. All guarantees, warranties, terms, conditions and representations implied by statute or otherwise are expressly excluded to the maximum extent permitted by law.
- 6.7** The Hirer shall be entitled to the benefit of all warranties given by the manufacturer and/or supplier of the Goods (subject to the limitations and exclusions contained in the manufacturer and/or supplier's standard terms and the rights of the Owner as the owner of the Goods), insofar as such benefit is capable of being transferred to the Hirer by the Owner, provided that on the expiration of the Hire Period or earlier termination of the hiring of the Goods, the Hirer shall transfer the benefit of such warranties back to the Owner unless the Hirer has exercised the option to purchase those Goods pursuant to clause 3 above.
- 6.8** The Hirer represents and warrants to the Owner that it has obtained from the manufacturer and/or supplier of the Goods appropriate and prudent representations and warranties in relation to the Goods.
- 6.9** If the law requires terms to be implied into this Agreement, then the Hirer and the Owner hereby agree that the Owner is not liable for any breach of such terms as if the breach of any such term had been allocated differently, the Owner would have increased the amount of the Payments payable or would have not entered into this Agreement.
- 6.10** The Owner shall not be liable to the Hirer:
- 6.10.1** in contract, delict, tort or otherwise for any loss, injury or damage arising by reason of any deficiencies or defects in the Goods, whether such deficiencies or defects be latent or apparent on examination (other than liability for death or personal injury arising from the Owner's negligence);
- 6.10.2** for any statement, term, condition, warranty or representation made by any supplier, dealer, agent, broker or other person through whom this transaction may have been introduced, negotiated or conducted (and persons other than those employed by the Owner have no authority, express or implied, to act as the Owner's agent);
- 6.10.3** either for any loss suffered by the Hirer as a result of the Goods or any part of the Goods being unusable, or to supply any replacement Goods (or any part) during any period when the Goods or part of them are unusable;

**6.10.4** for any loss or damage incurred or sustained by the Hirer in consequence of the Owner terminating the hiring under clause 10 or in re-taking possession of the Goods; and/or

**6.10.5** for any delay in delivery of or a failure to deliver the Goods.

**6.11** The Owner's liability to the Hirer for any breach of this Agreement shall not under any circumstances exceed an amount equal to the aggregate of the total Payments due under this Agreement.

**6.12** The Owner gives no warranties that the Goods do not or that the Hirer's use of the Goods will not infringe any patents, trademarks, registered designs, copyrights or intellectual property rights owned or possessed by any third party and the Owner shall not be liable to the Hirer for any loss suffered by the Hirer in any way as a result of any infringement.

#### **7 Insurance**

**7.1** Risk in the Goods shall pass to the Hirer upon their delivery and shall remain with the Hirer until the Hire Period has expired and the Goods are returned to the Owner or title has passed to the Hirer in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

**7.2** The Hirer shall take out the following insurances with a reputable insurer duly authorised to carry on insurance business in the United Kingdom, from the date the Goods are delivered to the Hirer until the Goods are returned to the Owner or title has passed to the Hirer in accordance with the terms of this Agreement:

**7.2.1** fully comprehensive insurance in respect of the Goods for all insurable risks in an amount not less than the full replacement value of the Goods with no unusual excess or exclusions. In the event that the Goods comprise a motor vehicle such insurance shall cover risks that are required to be covered by the Road Traffic Act 1991 or any modification or re-enactment of it and any other risks which the Hirer is obliged by law to insure against; and

**7.2.2** third party liability insurance covering both the Owner and the Hirer against liability to third persons for death, personal injury, and damage to or loss of property arising directly or indirectly out of the use, possession or operation of the Goods for such amount as the Owner may stipulate from time to time or in the absence of such stipulated amount for such amount as is prudent in all the circumstances, such policy to provide that any payments made under it be made directly in or towards satisfaction of the claim in respect of which such payment is made.

**7.3** The Hirer shall arrange to note the Owner's interest on any policy of insurance as the owner of the Goods and loss payee of any insurance proceeds and agrees to assign its insurance rights to the Owner upon request. The Hirer must produce evidence of such insurance to the Owner on demand. If the Hirer fails to insure the Goods or fails to provide evidence on request then the Owner shall have the right but not the obligation to insure the Goods at the Hirer's expense and to increase the Payments payable under this Agreement accordingly.

**7.4** If the Hirer makes an insurance claim, then the Hirer must notify the Owner immediately.

**7.5** The Hirer shall hold any insurance monies which it receives in respect of the Goods on trust for the Owner and shall pay the same to the Owner within 7 days receipt of the same unless otherwise agreed by the Owner. The Owner may apply any insurance monies (at its option) towards the cost of repair or reinstatement of the Goods or towards payment of any sum or sums due to the Owner under this Agreement.

**7.6** In relation to all insurances referred to in this clause 7, such insurances shall:

**7.6.1** provide that the Owner is given at least 30 days' prior notice of any cancellation amendment or non-renewal;

**7.6.2** provide that the Owner's and any other additional insured's interests shall not be invalidated by any act or omission or breach of warranty or misrepresentations of the Hirer or its servants or agents; and

**7.6.3** provide a waiver by insurers of any right of subrogation against the Owner and of any right of contribution from any other insurance carried by the Owner.

#### **8 Total Loss of the Goods**

**8.1** The Hirer shall inform the Owner in writing immediately upon the confiscation of or any loss of or damage to the Goods. If the Goods are irreparably damaged, destroyed, lost, stolen or (in the Owner's or the insurer's opinion) cannot be economically rectified (each a Total Loss), the Hirer shall at the option of the Owner:

**8.1.1** within 28 days of the occurrence giving rise to the Total Loss, replace the relevant Goods at its own expense with goods of the same specification, age and condition. Any replacement goods shall become the property of the Owner and shall be deemed to be Goods for the purposes of this Agreement. The Hirer shall do anything necessary to ensure that any replacement goods become the property of the Owner; or

**8.1.2** on the expiry of 28 days after the occurrence giving rise to the Total Loss, the Hirer shall pay to the Owner an amount which, when added to any insurance proceeds received by the Owner in respect of the relevant Goods, equals the sum calculated under clause 11 as if the Owner had been entitled to terminate and had terminated the hiring of the relevant Goods under clause 10.1 on the date of the occurrence giving rise to the Total Loss, provided that such sum shall be paid together with accrued interest thereon calculated in accordance with clause 2.4 from the date of the Total Loss until the date of payment.

**8.2** On the Owner's receipt of the amount set out in this clause 8.1, this Agreement and the hiring of the Goods, or such part of this Agreement as it relates to the hiring of the Goods the subject of the Total Loss, shall terminate. If there is more than one item of Goods and not all of the Goods suffers such Total Loss, then the hiring will terminate only in relation to the item or items in question and the sum payable pursuant to clause 8.1.2 shall be calculated by reference to the proportion of the Payments attributable to the Goods the subject of the Total Loss (as conclusively determined by the Owner). Any Payments remaining to be paid in respect of the remaining Goods shall be recalculated by the Owner to maintain its net rate of return and notified to the Hirer.

**8.3** The Hirer will use its best endeavours to procure prompt payment of any insurance proceeds payable by an insurer to the Owner.

#### **9 Indemnity**

**9.1** The Hirer agrees to indemnify the Owner (and keep the Owner indemnified on demand) against all losses, charges, damages, legal expenses (on a full indemnity basis), proceedings, judgements, decrees and liabilities whenever arising directly or indirectly from the Hirer's failure or alleged failure to comply with any of its obligations under this Agreement; or by reason of any loss, injury or damage suffered by any person in connection with the design, manufacture, testing, delivery, possession, hiring, transportation, maintenance, ownership, condition, insurance, use, operation, removal, return, sale or disposal of the Goods or any defect of the Goods; or by reason of any loss or damage to the Goods (insofar as the Owner shall not be reimbursed for the same out of any proceeds of insurance in respect of the Goods) occurring at any time before the Goods are redelivered to or recovered by the Owner, regardless of the cause of the loss or damage; or in connection with the affixation or removal of the Goods to or from the land or buildings at which they are located.

**9.2** The provisions of this clause 9 shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding the termination of this Agreement for any reason.

#### **10 Events of Default**

**10.1** If:

**10.1.1** the Hirer fails to pay any sum payable due to the Owner under this Agreement within 3 days of its due date for such payment;

- 10.1.2** the Hirer breaches or fails to perform any of the Hirer's other obligations under this Agreement and in the case of a remediable breach, such breach is not remedied within 5 days of its occurrence;
  - 10.1.3** any representation or statement made or deemed to have been made by the Hirer in connection with this Agreement is or proves to have been incorrect or misleading in any material respect when made or deemed to have been made;
  - 10.1.4** there shall be any change in the control, ownership or shareholding of the Hirer or any Guarantor from that existing at the Date of this Agreement;
  - 10.1.5** any event occurs which has or is likely to have in the Owner's opinion a material adverse effect on the Hirer's or any Guarantor's business, properties or condition, financial or otherwise, or on the Hirer's or any Guarantor's ability to duly perform and observe any of its obligations under this Agreement;
  - 10.1.6** the Hirer or any Guarantor ceases or threatens to cease to carry on the whole or a substantial part of its business or disposes or threatens to dispose of the whole or a substantial part of its undertaking or assets;
  - 10.1.7** the Hirer becomes insolvent or is deemed to become insolvent or is unable or admits inability to pay its debts as they fall due or has a petition presented against it for bankruptcy or a liquidator, provisional liquidator, receiver, administrative receiver, administrator, judicial factor, trustee or other similar officer is appointed in respect of the Hirer or any of its assets (otherwise than for the purposes of a solvent reconstruction or amalgamation) or any steps are taken to appoint the same;
  - 10.1.8** in the case of the Hirer being a partnership, a trustee or judicial factor is appointed or, in the case of the Hirer being an individual, a trustee is appointed either by order of the court or by application of the individual to the Accountant in Bankruptcy in terms of the Bankruptcy (Scotland) Act 2016;
  - 10.1.9** the Hirer, being a partnership, is dissolved or proceedings for its dissolution are commenced or any of the partners dies;
  - 10.1.10** the Hirer (or any of its partners) has an interim or bankruptcy or sequestration order made against it or receives a statutory demand under the Insolvency Act 1986, or the Bankruptcy (Scotland) Act 2016;
  - 10.1.11** in the case of the Hirer being an individual or partnership, the Hirer is apparently insolvent within the meaning of section 16 of the Bankruptcy (Scotland) Act 2016;
  - 10.1.12** the Hirer shall permit any diligence, distress, execution or other legal process to be done or levied against its assets or any part thereof (or, in Scotland, a right of hypothec is exercised over the Hirer's assets (or any part thereof) or any form of diligence is done or threatened by a third party affecting the Hirer's assets (or any part thereof));
  - 10.1.13** the Hirer makes or proposes any composition or scheme of arrangement or trust deed with its creditors or calls a meeting of them;
  - 10.1.14** there is a default in the performance of, or a breach of, any of the Hirer's obligations under any other agreement between the Hirer and any member of the Owner's Group;
  - 10.1.15** any company in the Hirer's Group breaches a term of any agreement from time to time made between it and the Owner or any other company which is a member of the Hirer's Group;
  - 10.1.16** the Hirer or any other company in the Hirer's Group defaults under any finance product with any third party, including but not limited to a finance agreement or other agreement or obligation relating to borrowing or under any guarantee;
  - 10.1.17** the Hirer is subject to an event similar to any event set out in clauses 10.1.7 to 10.1.13 in any other jurisdiction; and/or
  - 10.1.18** any event set out in clauses 10.1.7 to 10.1.16 occurs in relation to any Guarantor,
- the Owner shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement and the hiring of the Goods and repossess the Goods.

#### **11 Consequences of Termination**

- 11.1** Upon the hiring of the Goods being terminated under clause 10, the Hirer shall pay to the Owner a sum equal to the aggregate of:
  - 11.1.1** all arrears of Payments and other sums due up to the date of termination including any interest due on any unpaid amounts;
  - 11.1.2** the balance of the Payments that would have been payable during the remainder of the Hire Period (save for such termination) less a rebate of 1% per annum on each of such Payments calculated on a day to day basis from the date each of such Payments would but for such termination have become payable up to the date of such termination;
  - 11.1.3** all costs, losses, expenses (including legal fees) and liabilities incurred by the Owner, directly or indirectly in connection with terminating or redeploying any funding arrangement (including but without limitation any swap) in place in respect of this Agreement and its acquisition of the Goods, on or following the termination or expiry of this Agreement or the hiring of the Goods;
  - 11.1.4** damages for any breach of this Agreement and all expenses and costs (including legal fees) incurred by the Owner in retaking possession of and selling or attempting to sell the Goods and/or enforcing the Owner's rights under this Agreement; and
  - 11.1.5** all interest accrued on the amounts payable under 11.1.2 to 11.1.4 above.

#### **12 Return of the Goods**

- 12.1** Subject to clause 12.5, on termination or expiry of this Agreement or the hiring of the Goods thereunder, the Hirer will deliver up the Goods at its own cost and expense (including the cost of removal and dismantling costs), serviced and maintained and in good repair and working order (other than deterioration through fair wear and tear), together with all records, log books, handbooks, certificates, licenses, registrations, permits, authorisations required (if any) in respect thereof, to such address in the United Kingdom as the Owner shall notify to the Hirer.
- 12.2** Subject to clause 12.5, the Hirer shall allow the Owner or its nominee access to any premises where the Goods may be for the purpose of inspecting and removing them and if the Owner reasonably requires the Hirer will carry out any servicing, maintenance, repair or other work to the Goods so as to put them in the condition specified in clause 5.2 and the Hirer will reimburse the reasonable cost thereof plus VAT to the Owner or its nominee upon demand. The delivery up of the Goods by the Hirer at the expiration of the Hire Period or upon earlier termination of this Agreement or the hiring under it, shall be of the essence and a condition of this Agreement.
- 12.3** Subject to clause 12.5, if the Hirer fails to redeliver the Goods to the Owner or its agent in accordance with clauses 12.1 and 12.2 within a reasonable time of being requested so to do by the Owner, then the Owner or its agent may at any time enter into the Hirer's premises or any place where the Goods are from time to time situate and remove the Goods and for this purpose the Hirer grants an irrevocable licence to the Owner and its agents to enter upon the premises where the Goods may be located. The Owner shall not be liable in any way for or in respect of any damage or loss thereby caused to such premises or otherwise, and the Hirer shall indemnify the Owner in respect of any claim whatsoever which may be made against the Owner by any landlord or other third party in respect of such damage or loss, including economic loss.
- 12.4** Subject to clause 12.5, if the Hirer retains possession or use of the Goods or any item thereof (with or without the consent of the Owner) after the expiry of this Agreement or termination of the hiring of the Goods, the obligations of the Hirer hereunder shall continue as if not so terminated. Such use or possession of the Goods shall not be construed as a renewal of the hiring, the Hirer being obliged to deliver up the Goods or any item thereof in accordance with this clause 12 following a request to do so by the Owner.

- 12.5** Clauses 12.1 to 12.4 shall not apply in respect of the Goods where the Hirer has exercised the option to purchase those Goods pursuant to clause 3 above.
- 13 General**
- 13.1 In this Agreement, the following definitions shall apply:
- Agreement means the front sections of this agreement together with the Terms and Conditions and any other schedules or attachments hereto, including any Goods Schedule and/or Payments Schedule, which together comprise the agreement between the Parties in respect of the hiring of the Goods
- Business Day means any day (other than a Saturday, Sunday or a public bank holiday) on which banks are open for business in London
- Goods means the goods detailed on page 1 of this Agreement and/or in any separate Goods Schedule, and includes each and every component part, record, log book, manual and handbook for them and all substitutions, replacements and renewals of and additions to such goods and any part or parts which form an integral part of such goods
- Goods Schedule means a schedule, in a form and substance satisfactory to the Owner, entered into between the Owner and the Hirer in connection with the Goods and this Agreement
- Guarantor means any guarantor of the Hirer's obligations under this Agreement
- Hirer's Group means the Hirer, any Subsidiary of the Hirer, the Hirer's ultimate Holding Company and any Subsidiaries of such Holding Company from time to time
- Holding Company has the meaning given to it by section 1159 of the Companies Act 2006
- Owner's Group means the Owner, any Subsidiary of the Owner, the Owner's ultimate Holding Company and any Subsidiaries of such Holding Company from time to time
- Party means a party to this Agreement and together being the Parties
- Payments Schedule means a payments schedule, in a form and substance satisfactory to the Owner, entered into between the Owner and the Hirer in connection with the Payments and this Agreement
- Relevant Agreement means this Agreement and any other agreement between the Owner or a member of the Owner's Group and the Hirer and/or any member of the Hirer's Group (other than an agreement regulated by the Consumer Credit Act 1974)
- Subsidiary has the meaning given to it by section 1159 of the Companies Act 2006
- 13.2** Any reference in this Agreement to a provision of law is a reference to a provision of any treaty, legislation, regulation, decree, order or by-law and any secondary legislation enacted under a power given by that provision, as amended, applied or re-enacted or replaced whether before or after the date of this Agreement.
- 13.3** If the Hirer was introduced to the Owner by a broker or third party (Introducer), a commission will have been paid or will be paid by the Owner to the Introducer in relation to that introduction. The Owner has no objection to the Hirer asking the Introducer for details of any commission payable. By signing this Agreement the Hirer is consenting to the Owner paying commission to an Introducer.
- 13.4** Any certificate or determination by the Owner of a rate or an amount payable under this Agreement is, in the absence of manifest error, conclusive evidence of the matters to which it relates.
- 13.5** If the Hirer comprises more than one person, the Hirer's obligations will be binding on each person separately and all persons jointly.
- 13.6** The Hirer shall provide to the Owner, within 6 months after the ending of each of its financial years or other accounting periods, balance sheets and profit and loss accounts of the Hirer and any other such documents as the Owner may reasonably require. Any accounts are required to be in accordance with legal and auditing requirements.
- 13.7** The Owner may assign or otherwise transfer all or any part of its rights under this Agreement. The Hirer may not transfer any of its obligations under this Agreement or enter into any transaction which would result in any of those obligations passing to another person.
- 13.8** Any notice or other communication given by either Party to the other under this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered by hand or by email or sent by first class prepared post to the address of the other Party as appearing next to its name above or to such other address within the UK as may previously have been notified by either Party to the other. The notice communication will be taken to have been delivered on the same date if it is sent by email or delivered by hand or in the case of posting within forty eight hours of the date of posting.
- 13.9** No failure to exercise, nor any delay in exercising, on the part of the Owner, any right or remedy available to it under this Agreement, shall operate as a waiver, nor shall any single or partial exercise of any right or remedy prevent any further or other exercise or the exercise of any other right or remedy. The rights and remedies provided in this Agreement are cumulative and not exclusive of any rights or remedies provided by law.
- 13.10** If, at any time, any provision of this Agreement is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable in any respect under any law of any jurisdiction, neither the legality, validity or enforceability of the remaining provisions nor the legality, validity or enforceability of such provision under the law of any other jurisdiction will in any way be affected or impaired.
- 13.11** Where the Agreement is governed by English law, a person who is not a party to this Agreement has no rights under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 to enforce or enjoy the benefit of any term of this Agreement but this does not affect any right or remedy of a third party which exists or is available apart from that Act. Where this Agreement is governed by Scots law, this Agreement does not create any rights in favour of third parties under the Contract (Third Party Rights) (Scotland) Act 2017 to enforce or otherwise invoke any provision of this Agreement.
- 13.12** The Owner may set off any debt owed by it (and any affiliates or any other company in the Hirer's Group) against any debt owed by the Hirer or any other company in the Hirer's Group whether or not due. If the amount of the debt is unknown the Owner may estimate the amount.
- 13.13** The Owner shall be entitled to consolidate the Hirer's, or any other company in the Hirer's Group, liabilities under a Relevant Agreement. When calculating any amount due to the Owner under a Relevant Agreement, the Owner may (but shall not be obliged to) at any time without prior notice:
- 13.13.1** set-off or apply any debit balances against any credit balances on or under any Relevant Agreement; or
- 13.13.2** set-off or apply:
- (i) any sums paid to the Owner or any other company in the Owner's Group under a Relevant Agreement;
  - (ii) any net sale proceeds realised on disposal of any goods the subject of a Relevant Agreement; or
  - (iii) any damages and/or sums awarded to the Owner or any other company in the Owner's Group following judgment of, or decree in relation to, an issue arising from a Relevant Agreement against any losses realised pursuant to a Relevant Agreement, against any sum due by the Hirer or any other company in the Hirer's Group to the Owner or any other company in the Owner's Group under a Relevant Agreement.

- 13.15** Where the address of the Hirer stated in the Hirer details section overleaf is in England or Wales, the Parties to this Agreement irrevocably agree that the courts of England shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this Agreement or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) and no Party will argue to the contrary. Where the address of the Hirer stated in the Hirer details section overleaf is in Scotland, the Parties to this Agreement irrevocably agree that the courts of Scotland shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this Agreement or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) and no Party will argue to the contrary.

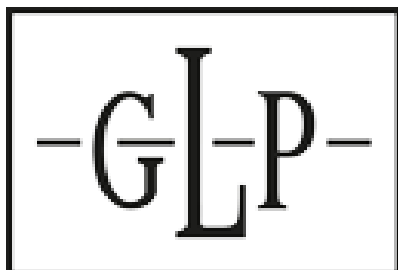
